

1st circular: International workshop “New aspects of the Hadron and Astro/Nuclear Physics”.

Tashkent, November 5-10, 2018.

General information

The National University of Uzbekistan (NUU, Tashkent, Uzbekistan) together with Inha University in Tashkent (IUT, Tashkent, Uzbekistan) and Inha University (IU, Incheon, Korea) organizes the International workshop “New aspects of the Hadron and Astro/Nuclear Physics”. The workshop will be an official international event devoted to the 100years celebration National University of Uzbekistan and will concentrate on the following scientific topics:

- Nonperturbative QCD, Confinement Problem,
- Heavy-Light and Heavy-Quark Systems,
- Strangeness Physics, Few-Body Systems,
- Matter under Extreme (high density and temperature) Conditions,
- Heavy-Ion Collisions, Synthesis of Superheavy Elements,
- Nuclear Astrophysics.

The workshop will be held at the Conference hall of Physics Department at the National University of Uzbekistan during the period November 5 (Monday) – November 10 (Saturday), 2018.

The workshop aim is to bring together theoreticians and experimentalists together to discuss the modern problems of the hadron and nuclear astro/physics. We encourage participation of young scientists, postdocs, PhD and master students.

Working language of the workshop will be English.
