The purpose of this international workshop is to organize a collaborative effort between experimentalists and structure and reaction theorists to advance the study of neutron-proton correlations (also neutron-neutron correlations). In addition, RIBF Discussion with topics of neutron-proton correlation will be held together for the first time outside Japan.
