### **2<sup>nd</sup> Conference on Advances in Radioactive Isotope Science (ARIS2014)**

The 2<sup>nd</sup> Conference on Advances in Radioactive Isotopes Science (ARIS2014) will be held at the ITO International Research Center, on the campus of the University of Tokyo, in Japan, from the afternoon of **June 1<sup>st</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup>, 2014**. The first ARIS meeting was held in 2011 in Leuven, Belgium as a result of merging the International Conference on Exotic Nuclei and Atomic Masses (ENAM) and the International Conference of Radioactive Nuclear Beam (RNB) in its scientific part with the hope to be the flagship conference in the relevant field. ARIS2014 (<http://ribf.riken.jp/ARIS2014>) is jointly organized by the RIKEN Nishina Center for Accelerator-Based Science and the Center for Nuclear Study, the University of Tokyo. It is sponsored by the International Union of Pure and Applied Physics (IUPAP), and supported by several institutions in Japan.

On-line abstract submission starts from December 5<sup>th</sup>, 2013.

The early regular registration fee until May 1<sup>st</sup>, 2014 is 40,000 yen. Graduate and undergraduate students are eligible for a reduced early registration fee of 20,000 yen. After May 1<sup>st</sup>, 2014 a late regular registration fee of 45,000 yen is applied and 30,000 yen for graduate and undergraduate students. The fee for an accompanying person is 10,000 yen.

The registration fees cover the following items:

- Conference program and abstracts
- Coffee breaks
- Conference banquet dinner

For accompanying persons, the fee covers:

- Welcome reception
- Conference banquet dinner

Accompanying persons may not enter the scientific sessions. Registration will be completed with payment of the fee. Details for the payment procedures will be displayed on the registration web page.
