<REGISTRATION>

Those planning to attend ARIS2014 but have not registered yet are requested to visit the following web page:

The early regular registration fee until May 1, 2014 is 40,000 yen. Graduate and undergraduate students are eligible for a reduced early registration fee of 20,000 yen. After May 1, 2014 a late regular registration fee of 45,000 yen is applied and 30,000 yen for graduate and undergraduate students. The fee for an accompanying person is 10,000 yen.

<PROGRAM>

The scientific program includes invited talks, oral, and poster presentations. Plenary talks are 20 minutes long plus 5 minutes for discussion. Oral contributions presented in parallel sessions are 12 minutes long plus 3 minutes for discussion with a few exceptions. The preliminary program is displayed at:

<ORAL PRESENTATIONS>

Windows PCs and MAC computers will be available for your presentation. We would like to ask you to upload your presentation file to the PC in advance. It is also possible to use your own laptop. Further details will be provided at a later date to the presenters.

<POSTER SESSION>

Two poster sessions will be held in the afternoon of Tuesday and Thursday. The prepared panels allow for A0 posters, more precisely maximum sizes of 90 cm (W) and 210 cm (H). The top 20 cm should be reserved to indicate the poster number. Your poster can be fixed by pins available on-site. The best posters will be awarded during a ceremony in the final session of the conference.

<SOCIAL EVENTS>

A welcome cocktail will be held for conference participants and accompanying persons on Sunday evening from 7:00 pm.

The banquet dinner will be held on Wednesday in the Galaxy Room of the Hotel Chinzanso Tokyo (http://www.hotel-chinzanso-tokyo.com) from 6:30 pm. Sightseeing tours and a visit to the RIBF facility will be arranged for the afternoon of the same day. Please book your tour in advance through the registration web page of the conference. From these excursions, buses will bring you directly to the banquet dinner.
