The French-Japanese Symposium on Nuclear Structure Problems will be held in the RIKEN Wako Campus from January 5th until 8th, 2011. - Structure of exotic nuclei,
- Nuclear reactions of stable and unstable nuclei,
- Nuclear astrophysics,
- Superheavy elements,
- New facilities and equipment,
- On-going and planned collaboration
- Related topics

The Symposium will be organized on the basis of FJNSP LIA (French Japanese Nuclear Structure Problems International Associated Laboratory) in collaboration with EFES (the JSPS core-to-core project "Exotic Femto Systems").
